## The Roots Fieldtrips for 2016/2017

#### How do I register for the fieldtrips?

Each fieldtrip will be uploaded to Eventbrite (an online service) where you can register and pay for the fieldtrips of your choice. Not all fieldtrips are open to registration at the same time, as we progress through the year we will be releasing new links to an upcoming fieldtrip.

#### Where can I find the Eventbrite links for the fieldtrips?

These links will be sent out to you through the Roots newsletters, e-mails, support group announcements, Roots Facebook page and the Roots website <a href="www.roots-homeschooling.com">www.roots-homeschooling.com</a> under the fieldtrip link (you need to log in first to see this link. You can also go to <a href="https://www.eventbrite.ca/">https://www.eventbrite.ca/</a> and use the search function to look up Roots.

#### If I have questions about a particular fieldtrip who do I contact?

Each fieldtrip has its own organizer, thanks to the many Roots moms who planned them. Once a fieldtrip goes "live" be sure to scroll down on the Eventbrite page to see who the contact is for that fieldtrip, her contact information will be posted. Please do NOT contact the Roots office for information about the fieldtrips, we only know the details that have been listed on the Eventbrite.

If the fieldtrip is not "live", you need to wait until it is to find out the details.

#### Can I pay for the fieldtrips out of my family funding?

No, all fieldtrips need to paid by you at the time of registering on Eventbrite.

#### Can I submit the receipt from the fieldtrip for reimbursement?

If this fieldtrip falls in line with what you are teaching your children and is on your PEP (proposed education plan) for the year, then yes you can submit the receipt for reimbursement. You can print off the receipt from Eventbrite after you have registered.

#### Can non-Roots students attend the fieldtrips?

Yes, on each "live" event you will find details about when the fieldtrips will open up to non-Roots students. Kindergarten and preschool students of a Roots family are considered to be a part of Roots!

#### Things to Note:

- Below you will find an overview of the fieldtrips that have been planned for this coming school year. Please mark your calendar with the ones you want to participate in, you don't want to miss out!
- Keep your eyes and ears open for the "live" links from Eventbrite to notify you that a fieldtrip is open for registration.
